2026 Oregon State Senior Qualifying Tournament

PLEASE READ ALL TOURNAMENT RULES BEFORE COMLPETING ENTRY

All entrants must be at least 50 years of age by July 1, 2026, and be a current member of the Oregon State USBC.

Current members of any Professional Bowlers Association will NOT be permitted to bowl this tournament.

There are SIX separate classifications of qualifying based on age (as of 7-1-2026) for both Open and Women's Divisions.

See front of entry for age classification. Be sure you circle the Division (Open or Women's) that you will be competing in, and check the appropriate box for the age classification as of 7/1/2026.

Qualifying consists of two 3-game blocks (six games total) with handicap to determine standings. Entrants may re-enter this tournament, but may only cash once. All games may be bowled in one day, or over any two days of the tournament.

AVERAGES: Entering average will be determined in the following order:

Highest Standard/House average (21 games or more) for the 2024-25 Season (including Summer). If none, then

Highest Standard/House average (21 games or more) for the 2023-24 Season (including Summer). If none, then

Entrant will use an entering average of 210.

If the only average available is from a Sport or Challenge league of 21 games or more, it will be adjusted per USBC Rule 201.

Rule 319a applies: If a bowler has a current average of 21 games or more that is 10 pins or more higher than the entering average to this. tournament, it must be reported and used for the tournament. It is each bowler's responsibility to ensure average accuracy HANDICAP: Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 for each game.

The highest 6-game total with handicap in each age classification will receive a paid entry into the 2026 USBC National Senior Championship. They will also receive a Championship Shirt and reimbursement of up to \$200 for travel expenses (upon completion of the trip and furnishing OSUSBC receipts for said expenses).

In the event of a tie after 6 games of qualifying, the winner will be determined by the high single game score with handicap.

If a tie still exists, the next highest game with handicap will be used, and so on, until a winner is determined.

Prize ratio is 1 in 8 entries (each age classification).

Any situation not covered by these rules shall be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

Each entrant hereby agrees that the Oregon State USBC, its officers or agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if the entrant shall be prevented from bowling the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by way of national/state emergencies, or causes related to fire, lockout, labor difficulties, or any cause beyond the control of USBC and the Senior Qualifying Tournament.

All entrants give express permission to the Oregon State USBC for the use of name, photo or likeness in any form/media without compensation.
